COMPARABLE TESTS, PRAXIS I

Acceptable tests include but are not limited to:

PRAXIS I (Basic Academic Skills)

- California Basic Education Skills Test (CBEST).
- The Collegiate Assessment of Academic Proficiency (CAAP).
- College Basic Academic Subjects Examination.
- State of Illinois Test Of Basic Skills.
- Florida Test of Basic Skills (College Level Academic Skills Test - CLAST).
- Connecticut Competency Examination for Prospective Teachers – CONNCEPT.
- LSAT – Law School Admissions Test.
- Massachusetts Educator Certification Test and Communication and Literacy Test (**Only for Reading and Writing**).
- Massachusetts Elementary Examination for only Mathematics.
- Miller Analogies (only for Reading).
- NBPTS Certification.
- Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC).
- PRAXIS II Secondary/Middle School Mathematics only for PRAXIS I Mathematics.
- PRAXIS II in the other content areas of English Language Arts only for PRAXIS I Reading and Writing.
- National Evaluation Systems, Inc. (Program for Licensing Assessments for Colorado Educators)
- New York State Teacher Certification Exam in Liberal Arts and Sciences
- New Mexico Teacher Assessments – two PRAXIS Series Tests (like NTE without Professional Knowledge, required by New Mexico's Department of Education)
- GRE (Graduate Record Examinations) or GMAT (Graduate Management Admissions Test). If scores meet or have met the requirement for graduate school, and degree was granted or person was accepted into graduate school, we will accept for PRAXIS I. If acceptable to an institution with scores received on GRE or GMAT, it can be accepted.
- Stanford Achievement Test Series.
- Texas Academic Skills Program (TASP)
- Washington Educator Skills Test - Basic

The New Hampshire State Department of Education does **not accept** ACT or SAT scores for either PRAXIS 1 or PRAXIS 2.
