**Definition of a dropout:** A 2005-2006 dropout is any student who completed the 2004-2005 school year but did not return to school in September 2005, or any student that dropped out during the 2005-2006 school year and did not return by October 2, 2006. Not counted as dropouts are students who were home schooled, suspended/temporarily expelled, transfers, truants, incarcerated, or deceased.

**Annual Dropout Rate** = Dropouts divided by the October 3rd enrollment plus students that dropped out before October 3rd.

**Cumulative Rate** =  $1 - (1 - \text{annual rate})^4$ . This formula applies the annual rate to a progressively declining base population. It represents the percentage of current students who will drop out before reaching graduation if the annual rate does not change.

(1) A different rate calculation must be used for high-migration schools. The annual rate is calculated by dividing the dropout count by the number of individual students enrolled throughout the year less the number that transferred out. Since the expected time till graduation varies with each student and is usually shorter than 4 years, the cumulative rate is not applicable.

(2) New Heights Charter Academy opened January 2006.

(3) Franklin Career Academy closed for school year 2005 - 2006.
