

**National Student Clearinghouse Signature Reports: Completing College: A State-Level View of Student Attainment Rates: NEW ENGLAND STATES ONLY - 2008 and 2009 COHORTS**

These NSC reports focused on two student cohorts. The first cohort entered college as first-time students in fall 2008. The research follows them through May 31, 2014, N=2,668,614. The second cohort entered college as first-time students in fall 2009. The research follows them through May 31, 2015, N=2,911,898.
