Educational Disability	Active IEP at any point of school year 2007-2008 (defined as Sept. 1, 2007 to July 1, 2008) from NH Special Education data system*
Limited English Proficiency (LEP)	October 1, 2008 LEP status from Fall 2008 district submitted LEP file
Socio-economically Disadvantaged	October 31, 2007 Free or Reduced Price Program status from Fall 2007 district submitted F&R file as part of BOY (beginning of year) files*
AYP Performance	NECAP (Fall 2008) and NH-Alt (school year 2007-2008) scores assigned to the teaching year school (school of attendance for school year 2007-2008) as defined by district submitted summer 2008 EOY files (continuously enrolled from Oct. 1 2007 through the end of the school year)*
AYP Participation	NECAP (Fall 2008) and NH-Alt (school year 2007-2008) participation assigned to school of attendance at the time of testing (for NECAP score: Oct. 1, 2008; and for NH-Alt scores: school that submitted portfolio)

Invalidation of Scores (recorded by content areas)	F modification as bubbled by school on student answer booklet, unapproved school bubbled E accommodations, and test breaches reported to and verified/recorded by NHDoE – entered during data clean-up phase
Invalidation of Non-Calculator Allowed item on Mathematics Session I	F-1 Modification as bubbled by school on student answer booklet by school or as test breach that was reported to and verified/recorded by the NH DoE – entered during data clean-up phase
Removal of student score from AYP reporting (recorded by content area)	Medical Emergencies reported to and verified/recorded by NHDoE, and First Year in US Schools ELL student (from district submitted fall 2008 ELL file or as bubbled by school on student booklet for students enrolled after Oct. 1, 2008) [Note: First Year ELL students do not have to take the reading and writing tests, but must take the mathematics test.]
