2009 AYP Release and Appeals Process Timeline

- Monday**
4-6-09 3 PM Public notification of school and district 2009 AYP results.
- Tuesday**
4-7-09 First day for school principals to submit an appeal to district officials.
 (Day 1 of the 30-day appeals process begins).
- Thursday**
4-9-09 9-11 (PSU Concord) *Understanding AYP and Growth Reports* workshop. Participants should bring their reports to examine as part of the workshop.

4-16-09 3-5 (Room 15, DOE)
- 4-9-09 1-3 (PSU Concord)** *Filing an Appeal* workshop. This session will provide an overview of the documents to be submitted when filing a school or district appeal.
- Friday**
4-17-09 4:30 PM *Intent to Appeal* filing deadline. Last day for district officials to submit the *Intent to Appeal* form for a school and/or district AYP appeal.
- Friday**
5-1-09 4:30 PM Deadline for Commissioner of Education to receive school and district appeals approved and certified by school district officials.
- Friday**
5-8-09 Commissioner's AYP Appeals decision letters sent to district officials. 2009 AYP determinations and School or District in Need of Improvement designations for 2009-2010 become official.
- Friday**
5-22-09 4:30 PM Deadline for school or district appeals to the NH State Board of Education.

We strongly recommend that any NEW Superintendents or NEW building administrators attend one of the *Understanding AYP Workshops* in preparation for inquiries from school district staff, parents, and community members.

FYI

Although Index Targets for AYP have not changed this year and individual student growth targets have not changed, the Annual Measureable Objectives for Growth have increased to 64% for Reading and 61% for Mathematics.
