To determine if the student did participate you need to also check the DidPart field. Note that for reading only First Year LEP Students are considered both "should participate" and "Did participate". For science and writing this field is blank.	
8	Partdiscode	For the given year for reading and math this is the district that NECAP and NH ALPs participation for the student is assigned for public schools. All students who should have tested at the school who did not withdraw during the testing window, did not enroll after testing started or did not have a special exemption are included. When determining if a student was included in the "should participate" calculations for a subgroup for the district you should check this field and the subgroup inclusion fields (PartSubGrp). To determine if the student did participate you need to also check the DidPart field. Note that First Year LEP Students are considered both "should participate" and also "Did participate" for reading. For writing and science this field is blank and not used for Adequacy reporting.
