Limited English Proficiency (LEP)	October 1, 2006 LEP status from Fall 2006 district submitted LEP file
Socio-economically Disadvantaged	October 31, 2006 Free or Reduced Price Program status from Fall 2006 district submitted F&R file
AYP Performance	NECAP (Fall 2006) and NH-Alt (school year 2005-2006) scores assigned to the teaching year school (school of attendance for school year 2005-2006) as defined by district submitted summer 2006 EOY files (continuously enrolled from Oct. 1 2006 through the end of the school year)
AYP Participation	NECAP (Fall 2006) and NH-Alt (school year 2005-2006) participation assigned to school of attendance at the time of testing (for NECAP score: Oct. 2 2006; and for NH-Alt scores: school that submitted portfolio)
AYP Attendance	Attendance rate for school (limited to grades 1-8) from district submitted summer 2006 EOY files
AYP Graduation	Graduation rates for school year 2004-2005 (for the districts at the high school level) and school year 2005-2006 (for high schools) from Information Services within NH DoE
Gender	Gender declared by district when SASID first assigned
Invalidation of Scores (recorded by content areas)	F modification as bubbled by school on student answer booklet, unapproved school bubbled E accommodations, and test breaches reported to and verified/recorded by NHDoe – entered during data clean-up phase
Invalidation of Non-Calculator Allowed item on Mathematics Session I	F-1 Modification as bubbled by school on student answer booklet by school or as test breach that was reported to and verified/recorded by the NH DoE – entered during data clean-up phase
Removal of student score from AYP reporting (recorded by content area)	Medical Emergencies reported to and verified/recorded by NHDoe, and First Year in US Schools ELL student (from district submitted fall 2006 ELL file or as bubbled by school on student booklet for students enrolled after Oct. 1, 2006) [Note: First Year ELL students do not have to take the reading and writing tests, but must take the mathematics test.]
