RE: Tutorial Services Program

The New Hampshire Department of Education is pleased to announce that as of April 9, 2008 the Southeastern Regional Education Service Center (SERESC) has been managing the Tutorial Services Program. This program is designed to provide tutorial services to special education students under the age of 21 that are incarcerated in one of the ten Houses of Corrections throughout the state.

Each House of Corrections is responsible for requesting tutorial services for a student by contacting Sheryl Porter at SERESC at (603) 206-6800 or sporter@seresc.net. After the New Hampshire Department of Education has verified that the student is eligible for special education services, SERESC will assign a tutor to assist them in continuing their education while incarcerated.

The NH Department of Education looks forward to working with SERESC, Houses of Corrections, and school districts in the continuing success of this program.
