Re: Part B IDEA Special Education Entitlement Allocation Revised ~ Fiscal Year 2012

The Commissioner of Education has been notified by the Director of the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) of the U.S. Congress passage of H.R. 2017 the "Continuing Appropriation Act, 2012." The "Continuing Appropriation Act, 2012" made an across-the-board reduction of 1.503 percent to the amount available for the FFY 2011 "advance-funded" allocation of the programs administered by the U.S. Department, including the IDEA Grants to States October 1, 2011 grants.

The State allocation to school districts was reduced by \$268,231.44 for FY 2012. Attached is the IDEA Part B Special Education Entitlement allocation for each school district. These figures have been revised from the original allocation sent on May 27, 2011.
