



For example: Grade 8 2013, Grade 7 2012, Grade 6 2011, Grade 5 2010, Grade 4 2009. Each year new students are added and others leave so this does not represent a true "cohort". Note that grade 4 will only have 2 points and grade 3 will have 1 point (2013 result). Also note that results will only be shown for years when the student was taught in the school (or district).

These results are for the students who were instructed in the previous teaching year grade. For example: Fall Testing grade 5 is reporting the performance of teaching year grade 4.

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
