



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

To use this chart start from the right-hand side to find the 2013 results for the grade listed. Go left one year to the 2012 results. This is the result for roughly that same "cohort" of students for the previous grade. Continue back through the years and descending grades. For example: Grade 8 2013, Grade 7 2012, Grade 6 2011, Grade 5 2010, Grade 4 2009. Each year new students are added and others leave so this does not represent a true "cohort". Note that grade 4 will only have 2 points and grade 3 will have 1 point (2013 result). Also note that results will only be shown for years when the student was taught in the school (or district).

These results are for the students who were instructed in the previous teaching year grade. For example: Fall Testing grade 5 is reporting the performance of teaching year grade 4.

Note: This report includes NECAP data only. Students who did not take the test for any reason are NOT included. The denominator for percent proficient is number of students tested by NECAP (which is not a true representation of the student population). A student's assignment to a school or district in this report is not contingent on continuous enrollment (as it is in AYP reporting). Cohort report does not represent a true cohort. If less than 10 students are tested then results are not reported. Ethnic group designations have changed over time. Please see website for more information.
