

SubGroup Definitions for Longitudinal Reports

NECAP Longitudinal reports (1-5) includes NECAP tested students only. Students are assigned to the school/district they were in for the majority of the time of the teaching year.

NECAP and NHA lps longitudinal reports (6-9) includes both NECAP tested students and NHA lps tested students. Only students with an average daily membership (enrollment) in the teaching school of > 90% are included in these reports.

1	0 WholeSch	<u>Whole School/District/State</u> This is the Whole School/State/District for the given subject.
2	518 IEP	<u>IEP/SWD - IEP during teaching year (IEP/SWD)</u> Students with an active IEP any time during the teaching year.
3	520 Econdis	<u>EconDis - Economically Disadvantaged</u> Economically Disadvantaged Students based on the Fall of the teaching year USDA National School Lunch Program Submission.
4	514 EL	<u>EL - Current English Language Learner</u> This is the group of students who are English Learning students who are eligible to receive services as defined by the November ESS Submission of the given year
5	733 AnyEL	<u>EL - Any English Language Learner (current, y1, y2)</u> This is the group of students who are English Learning students (students eligible to receive services, monitoring year 1 or monitoring year 2) as defined by the November ESS Submission of the given year.

English Learners are defined as students eligible to receive services, monitoring year 1 or monitoring year 2.
16	301 Waiver EL only	<u>WaiverSubgroup - Eng Learner (EL) only - Not EconDis, Not SWD</u> This is the group of NECAP and ALT tested students who were English Learners(EL) as defined by the November ESS Submission of the testing year but did NOT have an active IEP at any point during the teaching year and were NOT Economically Disadvantaged Students based on the Fall of the teaching year USDA National School Lunch Program Submission. English Learners are defined as students eligible to receive services, monitoring year 1 or monitoring year 2.
17	302 Waiver EconDis only	<u>WaiverSubgroup - Economically Disadv (EconDis) only - Not SWD, Not EL</u> This is the group of NECAP and ALT tested students who were Economically Disadvantaged Students based on the Fall of the teaching year USDA National School Lunch Program Submission but did NOT have an active IEP at any point during the teaching year and were NOT English Learners(EL) as defined by the November ESS Submission of the testing year. English Learners are defined as students eligible to receive services, monitoring year 1 or monitoring year 2.

English Learners are defined as students eligible to receive services, monitoring year 1 or monitoring year 2.</p>
21	306 Waiver SWD EconDis and EL	<p><u>WaiverSubgroup - SWD and EconDis and EL</u></p> <p>This is the group of NECAP and ALT tested students who had an active IEP at any point during the teaching year and were Economically Disadvantaged Students based on the Fall of the teaching year USDA National School Lunch Program Submission and were English Learners(EL) as defined by the November ESS Submission of the testing year. English Learners are defined as students eligible to receive services, monitoring year 1 or monitoring year 2.</p>

23	732 ELComp>=4	<p><u>SuperSubgroup - English Language Learners (EL) with Composite >= 4</u></p> <p>This is the group of students who are NECAP or NH ALPs Tested students who are identified as English Language Learning students who had a Composite score >= 4.0 on the ACCESS for ELLs® test:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in 2009 or 2010 for Adequacy 2011 or - in 2009 for Adequacy 2010 <p><i>Example 1: for 2011 Adequacy if a student had a Composite = 4.5 in 2009 and a composite of 3.7 in 2010 they would be included in this group.</i></p> <p><i>Example 2: for 2011 Adequacy If a student had a Composite of 3.7 in 2009 and a composite of 4.6 in 2010 they would be included in this group.</i></p> <p><i>Example 3: for 2011 Adequacy If a student had a composite = 3.5 in 2009 and a composite = 2.9 in 2010 and a composite = 4.8 in 2011 they would NOT be included in this group as the check for composite >= 4.0 would be in years 2009 and 2010 only per the definition.</i></p> <p><i>Example 4: for 2011 Adequacy If a student had a Composite of 4.1 in 2008 and a composite of 3.6 in 2009 and a composite of 2.6 in 2010 they would NOT be included in this group as the check for composite >= 4.0 would be in years 2009 and 2010 only per the definition.</i></p> <p><i>Example5: For 2011 Adequacy if a grade 5 student was NOT identified in the Fall 2011 ESS Submission as an English Language Learning student even if they had composites score >= 4.0 in 2009 and/or 2010 they would not be included in this group. They would be considered NECAP/NH ALPs tested for adequacy</i></p> <p>The English Learner status is defined by the Fall ESS submission of the NECAP/ALT testing year (For example for 2011 Adequacy it would be the Fall 2011 ESS Submission for reading, writing and math; and the Fall 2010 ESS Submission for Science) .</p>

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24	734 IEPSG	<p><u>SuperSubgroup - IEP/SWD during teaching year and NOT EL</u></p> <p>This is the group of NECAP or NH ALPs tested Students with an active IEP at any point during the teaching school year but who were NOT English Learners as defined by the November ESS Submission of the testing year. (Note this includes only the NECAP and NH ALPs tested grades for the subject) <i>For example: for 2012 Adequacy for performance and participation it would be students who had an IEP at any point during the 11-12 school year for reading, math, science and writing but were not EL as defined by the November 2012 ESS Submission for reading, math and writing; and by the November 2011 ESS Submission for science)</i></p>
25	735 SESSG	<p><u>SuperSubgroup - Economically Disadvantaged and Not EL, Not IEP/SWD</u></p> <p>This is the group of NECAP and NH ALPs tested students who are Economically Disadvantaged Students based on the Fall of the teaching year USDA National School Lunch Program Submission who did NOT have an active IEP at any point during the teaching year and were NOT English Learners as defined by the November ESS Submission of the testing year. (Note this includes only the NECAP and NH ALPs tested grades for the subject) <i>(For example for the 2012 Adequacy it would be students in the 11-12 school year who were Economically disadvantaged based on the Fall 2011 USDA National School Lunch program Submission for reading, writing, math and science and did not have an IEP at any point during the 11-12 school year for reading, math, writing and science and were not EL as defined by the November 2012ESS Submission for reading, math, writing; and the November 2011 ESS Submission for Science.)</i></p>

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26	737 AllOthersSG	<p><u>SuperSubgroup - All Others - Not EL, Not IEP/SWD and Not EconDis</u></p> <p>This is the group of NECAP and ALT tested students who are NOT Economically Disadvantaged Students based on the Fall of the teaching year USDA National School Lunch Program Submission who did NOT have an active IEP at any point during the teaching year and were NOT English Learners(EL) as defined by the November ESS Submission of the testing year . (Note this includes only the NECAP and ALT tested grades for the subject) <i>(For example for the 2011 Adequacy it would be students in the 10-11 school year who were Not Economically disadvantaged based on the Fall 2010 USDA National School Lunch program Submission for all subjects and did not have an active IEP at any point during the 10-11 school year and were not EL as defined by the November 2011 ESS Submission for reading, math, writing; and the November 2010 ESS Submission for Science.)</i></p>
