THE RESOURCE GUIDE

The New Hampshire Pathways to High School Completion Guide was created to address the learning gaps from the pandemic, assist counselors in providing support and post-secondary planning, and give parents resources to help their disengaged students.

TOPICS EXPLORED INCLUDE

1. Alternative Learning Plans

Alternative Learning Plans are developed when a student, parent, and educator agree on enrolling the student in an alternative program.

2. Adult Diploma Programs

Adult Diploma Program classes, which are designed for adult learners completing requirements for an adult diploma, permit students 16 and older to enroll in academic classes to earn credits that can be applied toward completing a high school diploma.

3. High School Equivalency Certificates

The High School Equivalency Testing Program provides an opportunity for selected students and adults to study for and successfully pass HISET or GED tests that lead to the high school equivalency certificate.

4. Pre-Apprenticeships and Apprenticeships

Pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship programs provide high-quality, industry-driven skills needed in the workforce utilizing learning on-the-job under the direction of employers.

5. Work-Based Learning

Work-based learning is an educational strategy that offers knowledge and skills development through instruction or study in an employment environment.
