The <u>nutrition lessons</u> take 10-15 minutes for grades K-2 and approximately 20-30 minutes for grades 3-5. Materials are flexible so teachers can combine lessons or save parts of lessons for later. Most lessons contain activities and worksheets that students can complete individually, with a partner, or in a group. Curriculum connections to language arts, math, science and social studies are included. Bilingual parent letters in English and Spanish are also included for each grade. In grades K-4, the curriculum includes one lesson pertaining to a nutrition themed children's book.
