Established in 2014, this nonlapsing fund resides in the office of the state treasurer. *All moneys in the robotics education fund shall be continually appropriated to the commissioner of the department of education for the purpose of providing funding to school districts for the development of robotics teams, encouraging participation in robotics competitions, and to make robotics available to more high school students. REF: RSA 188-E:24*

All stakeholders are invited to take advantage of this opportunity to support NH's high school students, through investing in our secondary robotics fund. Expansion of STEM activities in our high schools will allow students to gain greater exposure to the advanced technology, necessary to maintain a skilled labor force, in support of the economic sustainability of NH's workforce.
