

NH Part B SSIP Stakeholder Input Team

Once the area of focus on preschool special education was identified, the NHDOE formally established SSIP Stakeholder Input Team. Participants were invited based on perspectives needed for development of the SSIP and specific areas of expertise. As the focus has evolved, the essential players were refined to ensure that stakeholders with the direct expertise, commitment and experience were included. The NHDOE reached out to the NH State Advisory Committee (SAC) on the Education of Students/Children with Disabilities (the State Advisory Panel), the NH Part C Interagency Coordinating Council (ICC) and other key individuals and organizations for representation on the SSIP Stakeholder Input Team.

Responsibilities assigned to SSIP Stakeholder Input Team by the NHDOE:

- 1) Support the analysis of outcome data for preschool children with disabilities
 - a) Articulate data points that enhance the understanding and measurement of child outcomes
 - b) Identify data sources that will inform the selection of the SiMR
 - c) Review and provide input on results of child outcome data
 - d) Provide recommendations on targets based on in-depth data analysis
- 2) Articulate key features of the infrastructure that supports child outcomes
 - a) Provide specific information to move to an in-depth infrastructure analysis from the already existing broad infrastructure analysis
- 3) Provide key information from diverse perspectives regarding potential root causes of low performance relative to the SiMR
- 4) Identify potential improvement strategies that are designed to improve child outcomes
- 5) Support the NHDOE with evaluation of the implementation of the SSIP (Phase II)
