



## Parent Involvement Survey 2018—Frequently Asked Questions

### What is this survey about?

The New Hampshire Department of Education (NHDOE) is conducting its annual Parent Involvement survey for parents who have a student receiving special education services. This survey seeks to understand how schools are facilitating parent involvement to improve services and results for children with disabilities.

### Who should complete this survey?

Starting in 2015, districts across the state were divided into two survey blocks. Survey Block B is receiving the survey this year. To find out if you should complete a survey this year, go to the second page of this document. If the district your child lives in (your child's district of liability) is listed, then you should complete the survey this year.

### Why should I complete this survey?

Your feedback is important to help improve services for students receiving special education services and their families. The survey is voluntary, but the more parents who participate, the more accurate the information will be in representing all families with children receiving special education services in New Hampshire. If you have more than one child receiving special education services, you should complete a separate survey for each child.

### Do I have to provide my name?

No, we will not ask for your name or your child's name. Your responses to this survey will be kept confidential.

### How will results be used?

Your responses will be used to help school districts improve family-school partnerships in special education. School districts around the state are using their data to develop a variety of activities including sponsoring workshops, hosting family/school meetings, and starting partnership groups.

### How can I take this survey?

You should have received one paper survey for each child receiving special education services in the mail in May. You can complete the paper survey and return it in the postage-paid envelope, or you can complete the survey at [www.NHParent.com](http://www.NHParent.com)

### What if I do not receive a survey in the mail?
