Re: New Hampshire Special Education Procedural Safeguards Handbook

Enclosed please find an updated copy of the New Hampshire Special Education Procedural Safeguards Handbook, dated April 2017.

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA 2004) requires that school districts provide parents a copy of the procedural safeguards (parental rights) only one time a school year. There are additional times when a copy must be given: (1) upon initial referral or parent request for evaluation; (2) upon receipt of the first State complaint or the first due process complaint in a school year; (3) when a decision is made to take a disciplinary action that constitutes a change of placement; and (4) upon parent request.

We hope that parents, special education teams, school administrators, school board members, other members of the educational community, and the New Hampshire community in general will find it helpful and informative.
