Compliance & Improvement Monitoring
2019-2020 Overview of Equitable Services Monitoring**

For the 2019-2020 school year the Compliance & Improvement Monitoring (CIM) process will include the monitoring of districts for Equitable Services that are provided to students who are parentally placed in a private school. We will be monitoring in a variety of areas per 34 CFR 300.130-144.

The monitoring will include:

- A district’s record keeping of students evaluated, determined to be children with disabilities and children served;
- Meaningful consultation with private schools and parents;
- The child find process and evaluation as it pertains to students parentally placed in private schools;
- Service plans: team meeting participants, review of service plans; and,
- Services

The monitoring timeline for 2019-20 is outlined below:
