

These NSC reports focused on three student cohorts. The first cohort entered college as first-time students in fall 2008. The research follows them through May 31, 2014, N=2,668,614. The second cohort entered college as first-time students in fall 2009. The research follows them through May 31, 2015, N=2,911,898. The second third entered college as first-time students in fall 2010. The research follows them through May 31, 2016, N=2,919,088.
