Public input can be delivered in several ways: by e-mail, written, or verbally at a committee meeting.</li> <li>There are guidelines for input, such as: <ul> <li>Be factual and objective; please do not mention a student and/or school staff by name.</li> <li>If appropriate, comment on positive things that are happening.</li> <li>Know the time on the agenda when public input is received.</li> <li>Limit comments to no more than five minutes</li> <li>Provide comments on things that need to improve; offer suggestions on how they can be improved.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
