The Board of Education is proposing to readopt with amendment Ed 505.09, relative to fees charged by the Bureau of Credentialing in the Department of Education. The following changes were made to the fees to account for the actual cost of services based on staff time:

• Intern Authorization, previously \$120, now \$500;

- Demonstrated Competencies-Materials, previously \$50, now \$120;
- School nurse license and renewal previously \$75, now \$120;

- Credential verification letter, previously \$25, now \$50; and
- Emergency Authorization, previously \$120, removed from table.

Additionally, the fee table was reorganized to put similar fees together, such as renewals and initial license fees.
