

Translation for iReport

What is iReport?

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires states to publicly report accountability data via the State Report Card. New Hampshire's iReport meets this requirement by displaying various data points including student demographics, summative assessment results, ESSA designations, and finance and educator information. iReport is available at the state, Local Education Agency (LEA) and school levels. It is typically updated multiple times in a year.

Translating iReport

There are two ways to have iReport translated. The public can request translation directly to the New Hampshire Department of Education (NHED), or utilize the Google Translate function available via Google Chrome. The first option, contacting NHED for translation, is recommended.

Option #1: Contact NHED for translation

To have iReport translated manually, please submit your request to {Amanda.C.Yasenchock@doe.nh.gov,} with the following information:

- Webpage link to be translated
- Language needed for translation



Translation is expected to be emailed to the requester within 2-4 business days, as a PDF attachment.

Option #2: Use Google Translate

As a temporary measure, the public also has the option of using Google Translate. Please note that the translations provided through Google Translate is not verified by NHED.

On your computer, open Google Chrome and Go to [iReport](#)

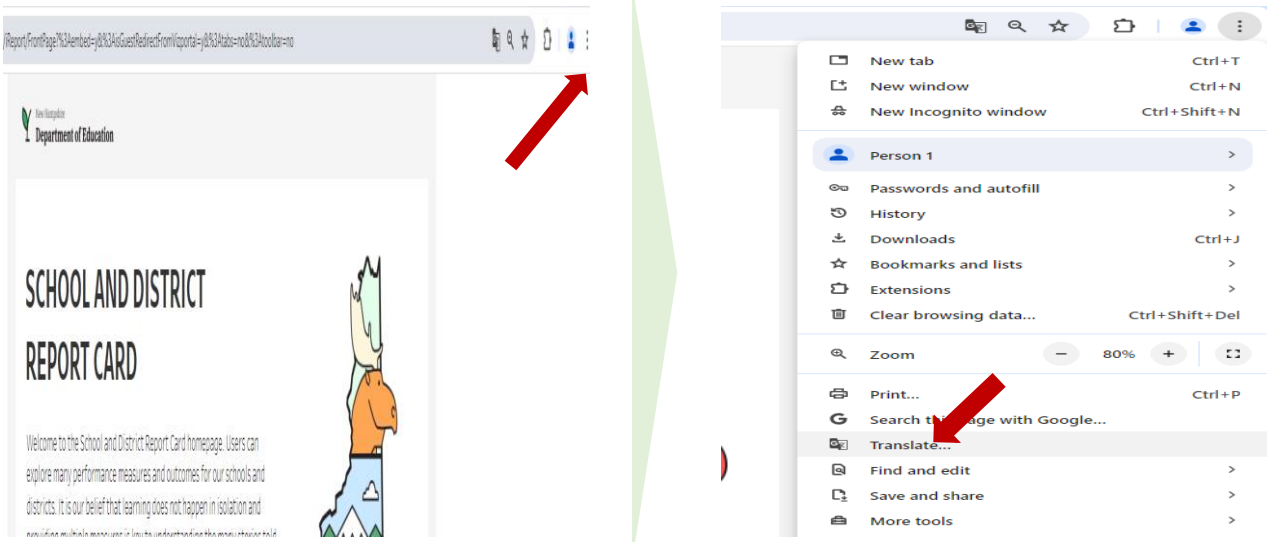


Translation for iReport – Cont'd
