# <u>Compliance Tip of the Month: Equitable Services</u>

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) includes separate provisions governing equitable services for eligible private school students, teachers, and other educational personnel, and families under <u>Title I</u> and programs covered under Title VIII, see <u>Part F- Uniform</u> <u>Provisions, Subpart 1- Private Schools</u>.

The term equitable services refers to the process of providing students, teachers, staff, and families at eligible Private, Non-Profits (PNPs) fair access to federally funded education programs and services, as appropriate, see **Equitable Services to Private School Students and Teachers**.

May 2023 Title I released <u>Updated Title I Equitable Services Guidance</u>. The Office of ESEA Programs will also be sending out helpful calculators for Title I and Title VIII.
