

#### CHARTERED PUBLIC SCHOOL FACTS

In New Hampshire, chartered public school do not receive local tax revenue. They rely on state per pupil aid, fundraising, and grants to sustain their operations.

Chartered public schools are required to renew their approval to operate every 5 years. This renewal looks at their student performance, operations, and compliance.

Chartered public schools are given an additional measure of flexibility and autonomy in their operation in exchange for additional accountability and dissemination of best practices.
