Frequently Asked Questions

Contract Provisions

1. **Question:** Does a statement for domestic preference really have to be on every PO and in every contract regardless of denomination?

Answer: Yes. Per 2 CFR, a statement for domestic preference must be included on every PO and in every contract. 2 CFR 200.322 does not state a specific denomination, therefore shall be included on all POs and contracts for all procurement of good or services.

2. **Question:** Does NHED have a recommendation for what a domestic preference statement should look like?

Answer: It is the BFCs recommendation that a statement for domestic preference resemble the following: The District provides “a preference for the purchase, acquisition, or use of goods, products, or material produced in the United States.”
