- Reminder: [RSA 189:13-a, IX(b)]. *Upon enrollment in an educator preparation program at an institution of higher education, a candidate shall submit to a criminal history records check. The institution of higher education in which the candidate is enrolled shall conduct the criminal history*

*records check. Upon placement of a candidate as a student teacher, the receiving school administrative unit, school district, or chartered public school shall conduct another criminal history records check of the candidate and shall follow the same procedures for assessing the candidate's criminal history background as for applicants for employment. The governing body of the institution of higher education may adopt a policy relative to how often a candidate shall submit to a criminal history records check. In this subparagraph, "candidate" shall mean a student who is enrolled in an educator preparation program at an institution of higher education in New Hampshire.*
