Screener Options and Eligibility Determination:

*Note: As of July 1, 2021, the WIDA Kindergarten Screener is the sole state-approved Kindergarten assessment to determine initial EL eligibility.

Pre-K Screeners:

Districts that provide a Pre-K program must select and use a standardized screening instrument (preLAS, preLAS Observational Tool or Pre-IPT) to assess English proficiency of potential ELs.¹ Districts may not use the current WIDA screeners for this purpose, as they have not been validated for assessing the English proficiency of students younger than 5.
