

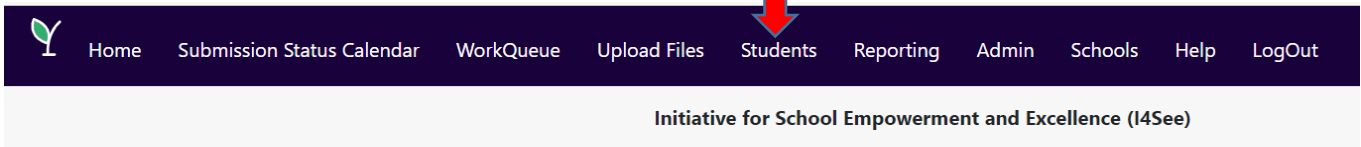
New Hampshire offers the **Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM)** as the alternate assessment for special needs students with the **most significant cognitive disabilities**. Students with the most significant cognitive disabilities participate in the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) alternate assessment, as indicated in their current individualized education program (IEP).

A student’s IEP team makes the determination whether a student with disabilities will participate in the general statewide assessment (NHSAS/SAT) with or without accommodations, or in the alternate assessment (DLM). Each school year, the special education director/coordinator/director of student services or designee provides a list of eligible students, who will be participating in the DLM alternate assessment, to the i4see coordinator/designee. The i4see coordinator/designee will then follow the steps below to register these students in i4see for DLM testing. Students who are eligible for the alternate assessment **do not** take the SAT or NH SAS general assessment.

DLM Registration Process:

- a. Login to [myNHDOE Single Sign On](#) and select i4see
- b. In i4see, under the ‘Students’ tab, select ‘**Assessment Roster**’ from the dropdown menu.



- c. Click on the ‘**All**’ option. Students can only be added for DLM testing via the ‘**All**’ option. To search for a student by SASID, enter 10-digit SASID and click ‘**Search SASID**.’

- d. Next, click on the (+) symbol under the DLM column {see above screenshot}, that corresponds to the appropriate student. A pop-up box will appear asking to confirm DLM student registration.
- e. To remove a student from DLM testing, click on the checkmark under the DLM column that corresponds to the appropriate student. This can be done from 'All' or the 'DLM' roster. A pop-up box will appear asking to confirm your action to unregister student.

In October, the NHED starts the daily process of uploading student data into the Kite Educator Portal for the current school year.

Teachers may choose to administer the optional DLM Instructionally Embedded Assessment to students. This testing window starts September 12, 2022.
