Step 1: Access Student Test Tickets in Kite Educator Portal

Students must have a username and password to login to Kite Student Portal to take the assessment. This information is included on a student's test ticket* which is accessed by the test administrator in Kite Educator Portal.

- A student's username and password are used for all test sessions for the current school year.
- Students must log in to Student Portal to begin testing. If needed, the test administrator may help a student enter their username and password as shown on the test ticket.
- Test tickets may be printed. **Test tickets are secure documents** and should be destroyed/shredded after student has completed all testing.

🔨 To access test tickets in Kite Educator Portal:

- 1. Select Manage Tests
- 2. Choose Test Management from drop down menu.
- 3. Click Search. A list of test sessions will appear.
- 4. Under the Tickets column, click the PDF icon next to the *Test Session Name* to open test ticket.

Note: An error message will pop-up if a user with the teacher role has not completed the required test administrator training.

Step 2: Access Test Information Pages (TIPs)


Test Information Pages (TIPs) are used by the test administrator to assist with planning for test administration and are subject-specific.

Suggestion:

- Before testing starts, review the test information page to collect any items needed for testing.
- A TIP may be printed. TIPs are secure test materials. If a TIP is printed, it must be shredded after the student has finished the testlet.

o access the Test Information Page:

- 1. Select Manage Tests
- 2. Select **Test Management** from drop down menu.
- 3. Select Search.
- 4. Under the Test Information column, select PDF icon next to open the Test Information Page.



Note: Test information pages for science, at the initial linkage level, have picture response cards that must be printed before testing. **Suggestion:** Print picture response cards in color.
