Title I, Part A Comparability Reporting

Districts demonstrate comparability in student to staff ratios by completing the required Comparability Workbook and applicable forms. The 2024-2025 Comparability Workbook will be tentatively released in October 2024. Data will use current student enrollment data for the 2024-2025 school year as of **October 1, 2024**.

Grants that Ended September 30, 2024

All reports, including a final report, must be submitted by November 14, 2024.

2023-2024 Carryover—NEW!
