Full Day Kindergarten Important Parent Information

• Please send your child to school with the following:

- Backpack
- A healthy snack that can be eaten in about 10-15 minutes
- Water bottle filled with water
- Change of clothes (underwear, shirt, pants, socks)
 - Be sure to label everything!
- School starts at 8:20- if a student is late they will need to stop in the lobby and get a late slip.
- **Morning arrival-** Please drop your child off by the big playground. Please do not let your child out of the car until it is time.
- **Dismissal 2:15-** Students will either be picked up by car or go to the after-care program (please call Rochester Childcare for more information regarding the after-care program at Gonic School)
 - For **<u>car pickup</u>** please meet us on the side of the building in your car.
 - Ms. Peterson's class- Please stay in the left most lane and pull up to the first blue door after the small playground on the left.
 - Mrs. Copp's class- Please stay in the right most lane and pull up to the door with railing on the back side of the building near the large parking lot.



- **Morning bus to school only-** Please check with the office if you are unsure as to which bus your child will take to school.
- **UP** (Rochester Child Care Center School program)- RCCC provides morning and afternoon child care! Please contact the program coordinator at (603) 332-9333 to sign your child up for morning, afternoon, or both sessions.
- On the first day of school- The bell will ring at 8:20. Students will come right into school and will be escorted to their classroom by a teacher. Unfortunately no parents are allowed in the building at this time.
- The first days of school are spent on classroom community, procedures, and expectations- WE PLAN TO TAKE IT SLOWLY UNTIL EVERYONE IS COMFORTABLE!

- **Snack Milk-** White milk is available everyday. Friday is chocolate milk day at snack time (white is available too). Snack milk is 55 cents.
- **Snack-** Please pack a healthy snack in a SEPARATE snack bag. 2 to 3 items max that can be eaten in 10-15 minutes. * The children love sharing their snack, but we ask them not to- Allergies and also because parents won't know what they've eaten.
- Lunch-
 - Complete the weekly lunch sheet (sent home in Friday folders)
 - Fill out lunch money envelope (include money for a whole weeks worth or pay online)- Lunch is free this year (milk included), if your child just wants milk and home lunch milk is 55 cents.
 - Hot lunch- Choices vary by day and all come with milk
 - Lunch from home- If your child is bringing a cold lunch, but would also like milk with their cold lunch, please be sure to clearly mark it on their lunch sheet. *This truly helps ease the confusion because most times children get confused between lunch milk and snack milk.

* Lunch menus are not available until the first day of school. Please send a note in with your child or dojo message to let us know what they will have on the first day!

- Please write a note or send us a dojo message if your child will **not** be going home in the usual way.
- Please mark **EVERYTHING** with your child's name: jackets, sweaters, backpacks, mittens, hats.....anything that is not attached to your child :)
- Friday Folders- These are colored folders that go home each Friday unless it has been a short week. Please take out all materials inside the folders and return the folder each Monday with completed lunch form.
- No toys, stuffed animals, or electronics please!
- **Core Knowledge Language Arts-** This is a new curriculum that we are starting this year. The students will get instruction in a whole group setting. This curriculum is given in two different strands; skills and knowledge. There are takehome papers that will be sent home weekly that will help your child practice skills at home.

- Everyday Math Series- This program is age appropriate for Kindergarten as the lessons and activities incorporate games to make learning fun and entertaining!
- Behavior Expectations- Be nice, Be safe, Do the right thing!
- **Conferences-** In November, more information to come.
- **Report Cards-** Our district runs on trimesters. First report cards will go home at conference time in November.
- Communication- We use a classroom management app in our class called Classroom Dojo. It has a messenger app...this is the BEST way to communicate, email would be the second best (Mrs. Peterson- <u>orrok.a@sau54.org</u> Mrs. Copp-<u>copp.a@sau54.org</u>)
