- As required by the Every Student Succeeds Act and in compliance with the NH Consolidated State Plan, NHED has identified 19 schools throughout New Hampshire as <u>Comprehensive</u> <u>Support and Improvement Schools</u>. Federal funds are awarded to the lowest performing, eligible schools for support services.
- This week, NHED issued a <u>technical advisory</u> in response to Gov. Chris Sununu's Executive
 Order 2023-04: An Order Directing a Statewide Response to the Impact of Social Media
 Platforms on New Hampshire's Youth. This TA provides social media curriculum framework
 and guidelines to help school leaders construct local policies to address the impact of social
 media platforms on youth.
