- This week, the NH Department of Environmental Services released a <u>report</u> of lead in drinking water at New Hampshire schools and child care facilities.
- Reminder that the **Beginning of Year (BOY) data submissions**, as well as Free and Reduced (F&R) data collections, should be live in the system on Sept. 15, batch verified by Oct. 6, and with anomalies resolved and district reports by Oct 18; data should be certified by Oct. 20.
