RE: 2022 Federal Quota Census to Promote the Education of the Blind (APH Count)

The New Hampshire Department of Education (NHDOE) will be conducting the registration process for the 2022 Federal Quota Census to Promote the Education of the Blind (APH Count). The registration process begins on Monday, January 3, 2022 until Friday, February 18, 2022.

In accordance with the Federal Act to Promote the Education of the Blind, each state must submit an annual registration of eligible infants, toddlers, students, and adults to the American Printing House for the Blind (APH), to determine a per capita amount of money to purchase educational materials produced by the American Printing House for the Blind (APH). Eligible candidates include infants and toddlers who receive early supports and services, students who attend public schools, private schools, charter schools, students who are home-schooled and adults.

The 2022 Federal Quota Census registration process requires that State APH Ex-Officio Trustees work with representatives from public and private educational programs and schools and other agencies to complete the registration process. The NHDOE is sending each district and agency who had an individual on the 2021 APH Federal Quota Count the 2022 APH Federal Quota paperwork via registered mail. Please use the 2022 Federal Quota Census Registration Resource Packet to complete your APH Federal Quota account updating, continuing and new individuals who qualify for the 2022 Federal Quota Census.
