Re: SPP/APR Stakeholder Engagement

The New Hampshire Department of Education (NHDOE), Bureau of Student Support (Bureau) is seeking stakeholder engagement (input) to set new targets for the FFY 2020-2025 State Performance Plan / Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR).

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires each state to develop an SPP/APR that evaluates the state's efforts to implement the requirements and purposes of the IDEA and describes how the state will improve its implementation.

The SPP/APR includes indicators that measure child and family outcomes and other indicators measure compliance with the requirements of the IDEA. Each year, NH must report to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) its performance in meeting identified targets in its SPP/APR.

Stakeholders will work with the Bureau to establish new targets for 16 of the 17 indicators listed in IDEA Part B. and have categorized them into 7 groups. Indicator 17, State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) will require a new target established for next year, as its current target follows through to FFY 2021-2022.
