Funding Opportunity

The New Hampshire Department of Education (NHED), Bureau of Special Education Support (Bureau), in accordance with the IDEA Part B Special Education Performance Plan, Indicator 14 [20.U.S.C. 1416(a)(3)(B)], is pleased to be able to provide funding support for your staff to assist with administrating the 2022 Indicator 14 Post School Outcomes Survey. To be considered for this funding opportunity, you must complete the attached fillable format Indicator 14 Post School Outcomes Survey Administration Funding application and return it via email to Mary.T.Lane@doe.nh.gov by October 1, 2022.

The grant funding is designed to support the allowable activities directly related to the indicator 14 Post School Outcomes requirements during the survey window (July 11, 2022, to September 30, 2022). Allowable activities include:

- Logging into the New Hampshire Special Education Information System (NHSEIS) and downloading the "Exit Report (Table 4)" to Identify the students within "Student Records" who are eligible to complete the survey.
- Preparing a letter that includes the survey link <u>bit.ly/NHEDpostgrad</u> that you will
 mail to your identified students who exited in the 2020-2021 school year
 encouraging them to complete the survey.

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- Emailing the survey link <u>bit.ly/NHEDpostgrad</u> directly to your identified students who exited in the 2020-2021 school year encouraging them to complete the survey.
- Calling your identified students who exited in the 2020-2021 school year and completing the survey <u>bit.ly/NHEDpostgrad</u> with them via phone.
- Posting the survey link <u>bit.ly/NHEDpostgrad</u> specifying who should complete the survey and instructions for completion to your district social media account(s).
- Monitoring your response rate through the <u>NHED Response Rate Dashboard</u>. Panorama Education is assisting the Bureau of Special Education Support with the survey administration process as well as the analysis and reporting of Indicator 14 Post School Outcomes data. If you need assistance with logging into the dashboard, <u>How to Login to Panorama</u> will guide you through the process. If you do not have a Panorama account, or wish to create an account for a colleague to monitor response rates, complete and submit the <u>NHDOE Indicator 14 Results</u> Access form.
- Contacting your <u>Regional Vocational Rehabilitation Office</u> and/or your local adult service agency(s) to request assistance with contacting your identified students who exited in the 2020-2021 school year that have become their clients to complete the survey <u>bit.ly/NHEDpostgrad</u> with them.
- Creating materials to inform the public about the survey results of the Indicator 14 Post School Outcomes survey for your district.
- Creating materials to inform students who exited this past school year, 2021-2022, about the Indicator 14 Post-School Outcomes Survey they will be eligible to complete in 2023 (1 year after exiting).
