Re: Special Education Aid (SPED AID)

The New Hampshire Department of Education (NHED), Bureau of Education Statistics has completed the calculation of the Estimated Expenditures of School Districts for the 2022 – 2023 school year.

The school district shall be liable for 3 1/2 times the estimated state average expenditure per pupil for the school year preceding the year of distribution, plus 20 percent of the additional cost, up to 10 times the estimated state average expenditure per pupil for the school year preceding the year of distribution.

The Estimated Cost per Pupil Tuition for Fiscal Year 2023 (2022-2023 school year) has been established at **\$19.034.08**.

- The CAP (3½ times the estimated per pupil cost) to determine whether a student's cost is eligible for reimbursement is \$66,619.28. The Department of Education shall be liable for 80 percent of the cost above the 3 1/2 times the estimated state average expenditure per pupil for the school year preceding the year of distribution, and up to 10 times the estimated state average expenditure per pupil for the school year preceding the year of distribution.
- The CAP (10 times the estimated per pupil cost) to determine whether a student's cost is eligible
 for reimbursement is \$190,340.80. The Department of Education shall be liable for all costs in
 excess of 10 times the estimated state average expenditure per pupil for the school year
 preceding the year of distribution.
