Lease Aid Renewal Application Due September 1, 2024

Eligibility: Charter schools are eligible for renewal if lease aid was disbursed to the school in SY 2023-2024 and no substantive changes have been made to the lease submitted as part of the previously approved lease aid application. Substantive changes include, but are not limited to, updating the lease such that it no longer meets Ed 323 regulations, reconstructing or altering the leased space, or leasing space beyond what was presented in the previously approved Lease Aid application. If such cases apply, the charter school may reapply for Lease Aid using the Initial Lease Aid application and adhering to the January 1, 2024 deadline in the application.

²The amount of lease aid is dependent on the amount appropriated by the legislature each year. Lease aid shall be 30% of the eligible amount, or \$50,000, whichever is less. If the lease aid appropriation does not fully cover the requested amount, aid is prorated among the eligible chartered public schools that applied.
