# Preparing for Fall In-School Testing

#### Device Requirements



Laptop,
Tablet,
School Managed Device
(Chromebook or Desktop)



Device should be able to hold a charge for 3 hours



Device must be able to connect to Wi-Fi



If a student doesn't have a device for **SAT Weekend**, they may request to borrow one from College Board and we will provide one on test day.

### **Device Specifications**

- Windows laptops/tablets must be running Windows 10 or later and have at least 250 MB of free space available.
- Mac laptops must be running macOS 11.4 or later and have at least 150 MB of free space available.
- iPads must be running iPadOS 14 or later and have at least 150 MB of free space available.
- School-managed Chromebooks must be running Chrome OS 100 or later and have at least 150 MB of free space available. You cannot run Bluebook™ on a personal Chromebook.

#### Network Requirements

All students and testing staff (coordinators, proctors, and monitors) must connect to your Wi-Fi on test day. This includes:

- Students and testing staff who are unaffiliated with your institution.
- Students and testing staff who are using personal devices

You may need to set up guest access. Be sure to share the network password with staff so they can share it with students.

Students will take the digital SAT Suite on a custombuilt digital exam application.

#### Bluebook™



If the internet disconnects during testing, students will still be able to progress through the test with no disruption.



If a student's device runs out of battery, they can simply plug in, restart their device, and pick up where they left off—all their work will be saved, and they won't lose testing time.




Bluebook automatically locks out other programs to ensure students cannot cheat.



Students are timed individually. If their start times are slightly staggered, their breaks and end times will be too.



#### Requesting Accommodations

- NEW: Starting in Fall 2023, accommodations for PSAT 8/9 must be requested and approved by College Board's Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD).
- The process for requesting accommodations for the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10, and AP will not change.
- Some accommodations requests will no longer be needed, such as:
  - Large print
  - Enlarged answer sheet
  - Magnification device

# Fall Digital Administration Planning

## **Key Digital Administration Steps**

Action	Description	Timing	
Ordering	Identify the assessments and grade levels you will be offering, when you plan to begin testing, and key staff	March - August	
Registration	Submit a digital file of test taker information which will be used to deliver test packages and accommodations	Late August - October	
Training	Complete training for test coordinators and other staff	September - October	
Digital Readiness	Ensure Bluebook is installed properly, check devices, and complete exam set-up, etc.	September - October	
Administration	Administer assessments based on your testing schedule	October	
Scores/Reports	Share scores and reports with students and families	November	

#### SAT Suite Ordering and Registration



SAT Suite Ordering and Registration (SSOR) is replacing the Test Ordering Site (TOS)



Access to SSOR will be provisioned using the Manage Access Tool.



District ordering is available.



Districts and school will be provided with an estimated cost when they place an order.



Districts and schools will **NOT** be invoiced based on orders.



#### SSOR Roles

#### **SAT Suite Ordering/Registration Access Manager**:

## SAT Suite Data Coordinator:

Upload test taker data for test registration

Assign this role to technology staff responsible for pulling test taker data from your institution's student information systems, and bulk uploading that data into SSOR

#### **SAT Suite Registration**:

Review and validate registration data, submit it, and register test takers

Assign this role to test coordinators and SSD coordinators responsible for reviewing and confirming registrations, including ensuring that all test takers who need accommodations have them provided








### **Pricing Calculator**

### SSOR Registration Key Highlights

- Registration will open at the end of August
- Staff uploading registration files need to be assigned the SAT Suite Data Coordinator role
- Staff reviewing and validating registration data need to be assigned the SAT Suite Registration role
- All students that will test must be registered
- Accommodations are matched to registration data to configure Bluebook
- Registrations can be canceled until days before testing begins
- Registrations can be added after testing begins
