Testing Window Closes	April 30, 2025

There is no separate make-up window. All testing must be completed by April 30, 2025.

### Upcoming Tasks and Due Dates

- Establish a College Board Professional Account- To complete required tasks, you will need a College Board professional account. If you haven't already done so, you can create a College Board Professional Account here:

- School Onboarding- College Board's onboarding survey will be sent out to principals to collect the information necessary to onboard schools for the Spring 2025 SAT School Day with Essay. New Hampshire requires the SAT School Day with Essay for

Grade 11 students. This survey must be completed for every school that has/will have 11th grade students in spring 2025. District/School staff are responsible for ensuring that all students participate in state accountability assessments-

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### Consider Offering the PSAT/NMSQT or PSAT 8/9 in the Fall

- A good score on the SAT can help your students optimize their college options or earn additional scholarships.
- The SAT Suite of Assessments **measures the core reading, writing, and math skills** essential for success after high school.
- The SAT Suite of Assessments provides a **standardized measure** to see where students are on their academic journey and identify learning and achievement gaps to **inform curricular planning, classroom instruction** and targeted student support.

To place an order, your institution will assign one or more **Access Managers** using the [Managing Access to support SAT Suite Ordering and Registration](#) tool. The Access Manager will then assign the **SAT Suite Ordering role** to the person who will place your test order. The [In-School Educator Experience](#) provides **detailed instructions** for this process. An online, self-paced [training module](#) is also available.

## Fall 2024 SAT Suite of Assessments Testing Window

- October 1-31
  - October 12 and 26 (supported PSAT/NMSQT Saturday test dates)
  - Your [order deadline](#) is based on when you plan to test.
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## Planning to Offer AP Exams in May 2025

- On **August 1**, AP coordinators and principals received an email with their school's AP Registration and Ordering access code for the 2024-25 school year.
  - The AP coordinator must complete the information in the Setup section of [AP Registration and Ordering](#), and then electronically sign and submit the AP Participation Form that is generated.

  - The NH Department of Education covers the cost of AP Exams for all public school fee-reduction eligible students. AP Coordinators must indicate student's fee waiver eligibility in AP Registration and Ordering.
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## AP Course Audit

- Completing the **2024-25 AP Course Audit** authorizes your school to use the **AP course designation** and gives your teachers **access to AP Classroom and other materials**
- Both administrators and teachers participate in the AP Course Audit.
- **All schools** that offer AP complete this process annually.
