Agency Responses to Proposer Inquiries

Question 1: How does one become a vendor for New Hampshire, and is it required for the proposed bid?

Answer 1: Please view Section 8 of the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the proposal content and requirements. This section outlines essential information which must be included in the proposal. Please note that being a registered vendor in NH is not required to submit a proposal. However, to move forward with a contract, a contractor would have to become a registered NH vendor, acquire a UEI number from SAM.gov, and follow the Standard Terms and Conditions of the State of New Hampshire, which can be found in Appendix B in the posted RFP, including, but not limited to, obtaining a certificate of insurance. More information on how to become a registered vendor can be found through the NH Department of Administrative Services' Vendor Resource Center.

Question 2: Is it possible for the investigations to be conducted remotely?

Answer 2: Yes, in large part investigations are conducted remotely. However, on-site investigations may be required, depending on the specifics of the allegation(s) in the complaint.
