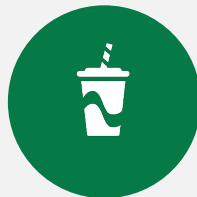
About the Business Enterprise Program

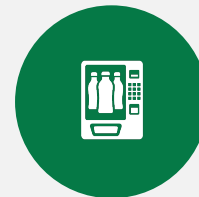

Provides pre-employment training services for youth who are blind or vision impaired



Offers services specifically for individuals who are blind, vision impaired, or deaf-blind and 55 or older, with a focus on independent living skills and peer support



Maintains New Hampshire's Blindness Registry, which entitles people to benefits ranging from tax deductions to educational opportunities to free fishing licenses
