Purpose

The purpose of this document is to provide Title IV, Part B subrecipients with information regarding the New Hampshire Department of Education (NHED), Office of ESEA Title Programs, 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) Title IV, Part B Grant Amendment Application procedure and subsequent form.

Guidance

In accordance with <u>30 CFR 735.20</u>, a grant amendment is a written alteration in the grant amount, grant terms or conditions, budget or period, or other administrative, technical, or financial agreement proposed by the subrecipient of Federal funds to the state education agency (SEA).

The subrecipient shall promptly notify the SEA in writing of events or proposed changes which may require a grant amendment, such as;

- 1. Rebudgeting;
- 2. Changes which may affect the approved scope or objective of a program; or
- 3. Changes which may increase or substantially decrease the total cost of a program.

Proposed changes must remain in alignment with the Title IV, Part B Federal program provisions, <u>ESEA section</u> <u>4204</u>, to ensure student success by providing academic enrichment opportunities during non-school hours for children, particularly students who attend high-poverty and low performing schools.

NHED will approve or deny a proposed amendment within 30 days of receipt, or as soon thereafter as possible, and shall notify the subrecipient in writing of the approval or denial.

The date NHED signs the grant amendment will establish the effective date of the action. If no time period is specified in the grant amendment, then the amendment applies to the entire grant period.
