Work-Based Learning Experience Payroll Guidance

Upon arranging a WBLE (Job Shadow, Trial Work Period) that a participant will be paid for, the following documents need to be completed and submitted to Charles.A.Lewis@doe.nh.gov for review a minimum of three business days prior to any anticipated experience start date:

- ❖ VRNH PE Participant Placement Form
- USCIS Form I-9 (Employment Eligibility Verification)
- USIRS Form W-4 (Employee's Withholding Certificate)
- McIntosh PE Payroll Verification Form
- McIntosh Emergency Contact Form

Note that only the first section of the I-9 needs to be completed, the second section will be completed by others.

Along with having the first section of the I-9 completed, we will require *clear, readable* photocopies or PDF scans of supporting documents (generally a state ID or driver license and social security card) from the lists on page two of the I-9.

Once a participant begins their work experience, a weekly timesheet needs to be submitted to process payroll.
